### **Professional Development Workshop: Continuously Building Your Pediatric Career**

Workshop topics include:

- Creating effective time management strategies
- Developing a professional network
- Pitching your research in 5 min or less
- Publishing early and ongoing research
- Building your mentorship and guidance teams
- Nuts and bolts of career transitions

Information: The session will include a combination of short didactic presentations by mid-career faculty on career development topics that cause significant anxiety (angst during periods of early career transition) with hands on activities to make them seem less daunting. Using small group breakout sessions, we will explore several common productivity pitfalls that cause fellows and junior faculty members to get off track with concrete examples of how to overcome them.
